COMMUNITY ORG'S PAIR TO PROMOTE ALLIED BEHAVIOR

Groups Mark Sexual Assault Awareness Month (April)
With Co-Ed Workshop

Men Stopping Rape, Inc. (MSR), one of the nation's first men's anti-violence organizations, will mark the annual Madison observance of Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM), which is April, with a co-ed workshop examining the ways in which men and women can and should work together to address dating violence, sexual assault, and domestic violence in our community.

"Allies in Ending Violence" will be held on the UW-Madison campus at the Memorial Union on Saturday, April 25, 2009 from 1:00p.m. to 4:00 p.m. The room location will be posted to TITU (Today In The Union) the day of the event.

This workshop will feature single-gender sessions – male-only and female-only – followed by a co-ed, mixed gender session, and will be co-facilitated by MSR, Dane County DELTA Project (a program within Domestic Abuse Intervention Services), and the OASIS, a program of Canopy Center Healing and Family Support Services.
